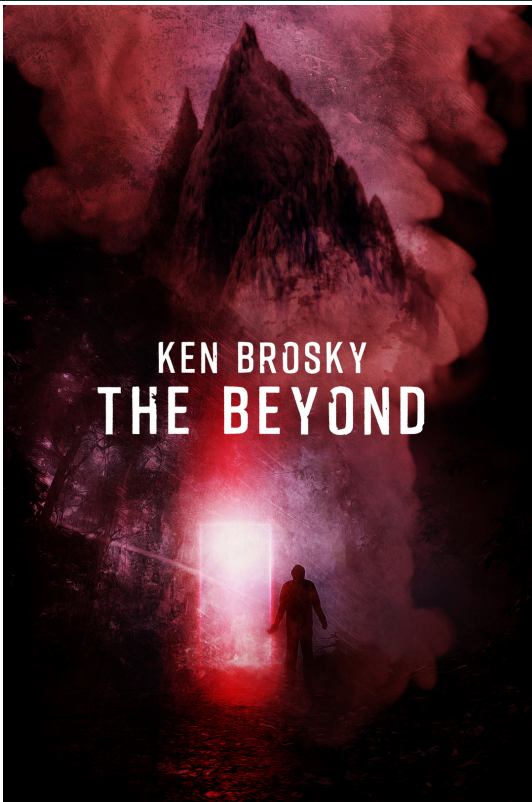


THE BEYOND
